Controllers of Personal Information

Any personal information provided to or to be gathered by marcguggenheim.com is controlled by us.

What Information about me is collected and stored?

We collect cookies to analyze certain types of information about usage of the Site.

How do we use your Information?

We use automated technologies to collect and analyze certain types of information we consider to be non-personal information, including: (a) information related to the devices you use to access or interact with our Site, such as: IP addresses, geolocation information, unique device identifiers and other information about your mobile phone or other mobile device(s), browser type, browser language; and (b) information related to the ways in which you interact with the Site, such as: referring and exit pages and URLs, platform type, the number of clicks, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed and the order of those pages, the amount of time spent on particular pages, the date and time you used the Site, and other similar information. Use of Cookies

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that is placed on your browser, hard drive, or memory of your device when you use Site. We use these technologies to analyze the usage of the Site. We use cookies or other tracking technologies that are:

Google Analytics
